This past year we replaced the water heaters in both the church and the hall. And earthquake shut-off valves were installed on our gas lines.

A leak was discovered on the north side of the church, inside the wall of the utility closet. The leak has since been repaired, and repair has been made to the wall. A big thank you to Kathy Baghdanov and Stilian Hristov for the help and hard work.

You can see that a retaining wall has been built at the entrance to our upper parking lot. This was done by Stilian (again) with some help from Liam, and Radoslav.

There are some projects that we are looking at in the near future. Kim Knudeson is going to be renting a stumpgrinder, and over one or two days will be working on grinding down several stumps around the property. Keep your eyes out for an email that may come out recruiting helpers.

We are going to have a roof maintenance company come and perform some cleaning and repairs on our church roof. An inspection revealed several broken tiles and a damaged valley, as well as moss buildup. This is all going to be corrected early next month.
